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HEROIN MISUSE QUERY SET

Heroin misuse is a common problem in the UK. The prevalence is unknown, with no centralised register of misusers and with a certainty that not all misusers are in contact with health services at any one time.

There are an estimated 150,000-200,000 heroin users in the general population in the National Enhanced Service (NES) Specification. Enough for every GP to have people dependent on heroin registered.

The main focus of these queries is heroin dependence because it is the only one of the illegal drugs to have prescription substitutes available and therefore to bring the users into contact with primary care.

This library aims to build a register of heroin misusers and tracks their current status. Thus we have divided the register into two groups, those who have ever used heroin and those who are currently having treatment for the problem.

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Elements of audit 1

- Engagement in therapy
 - Being seen for treatment at least twice in past 84 days
- Number on prescription
- Number ever injected
- Multiple drug use including alcohol

Blood-borne Viruses

- Testing for Hepatitis B status ever
- No recorded hepatitis B vaccination
- Incomplete hepatitis B course: <3
- Completed hepatitis B course: 3+
- Hepatitis C testing
- HIV testing

Elements of audit 3

- Evidence of adverse clinical outcome related to drug misuse: eg DVT, cellulitis
- Evidence of unemployment or sickness benefit
- Evidence of successful outcome or improvement
 - abstinence or reduction in drug use
 - naltrexone

Data quality check

- Number with heroin misuse treatment code without heroin morbidity code

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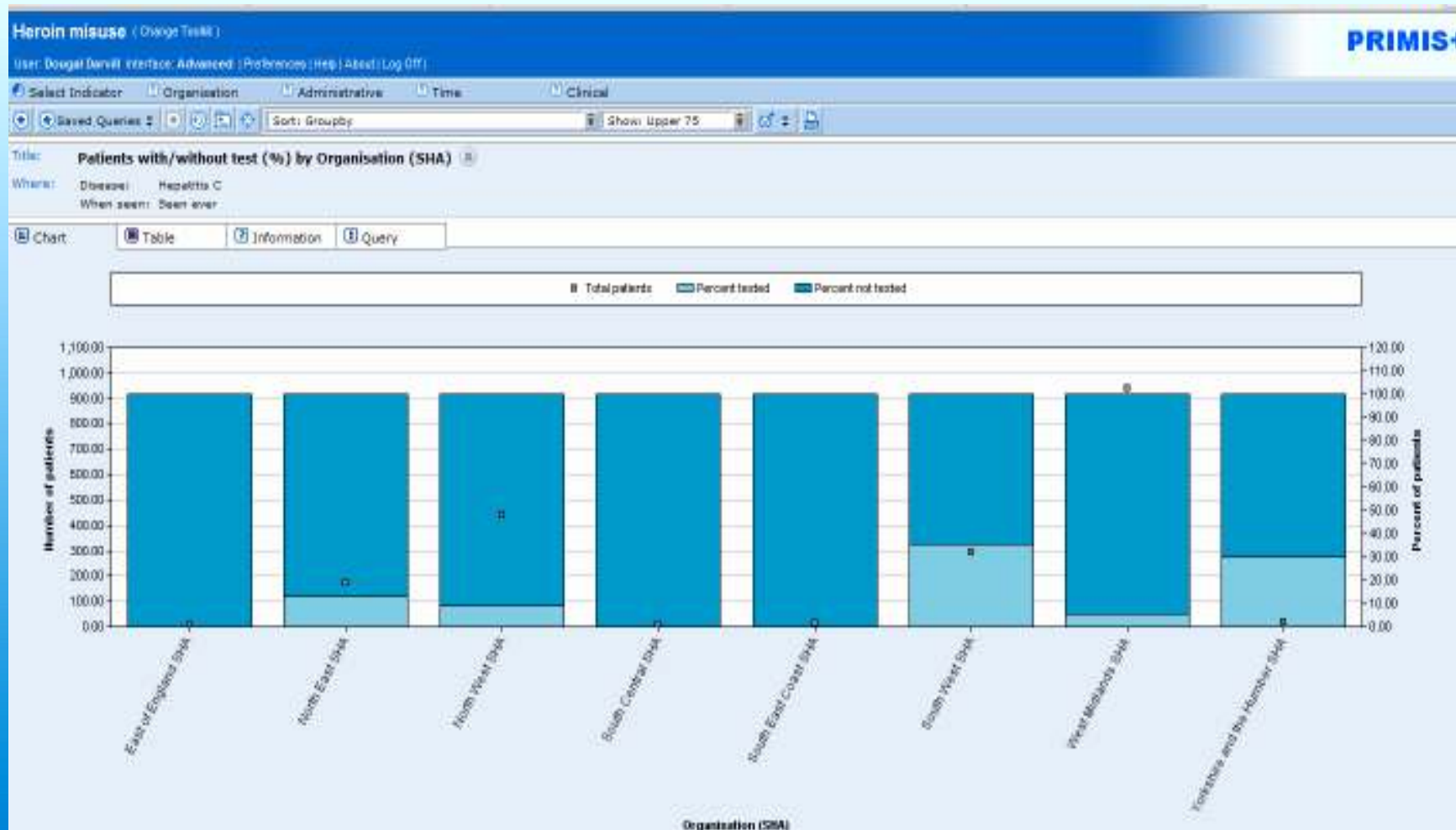
