- Ward level index
- Six ward-level indices
- Summary measures at the district level
- Uses data from 33 indicators



Ward level

- Income
- Employment
- Health & disability
- Education, skills & training
- Housing
- Geographic access to services

- Overall index of multiple deprivation
- Child poverty index

- Each category is scored and ranked (8,414 wards in England)

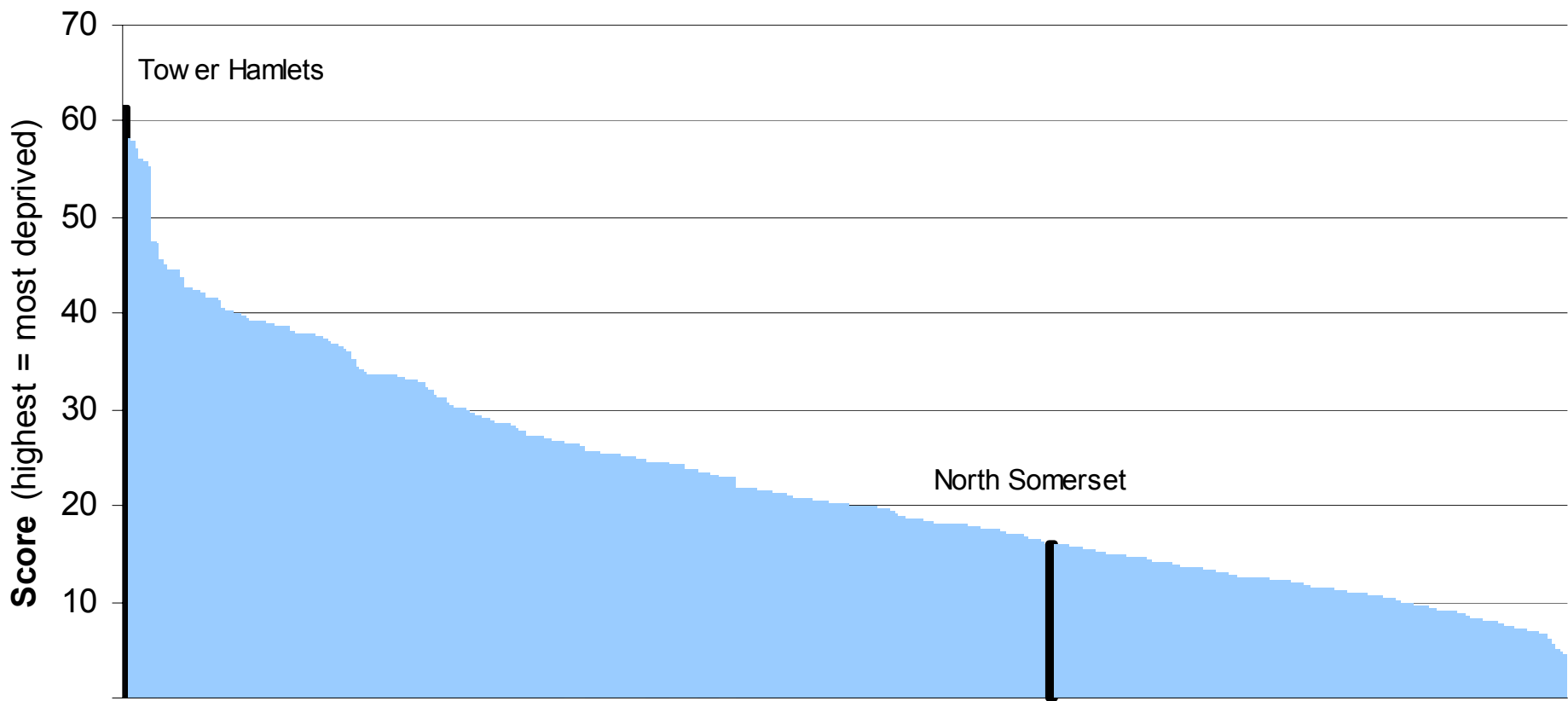

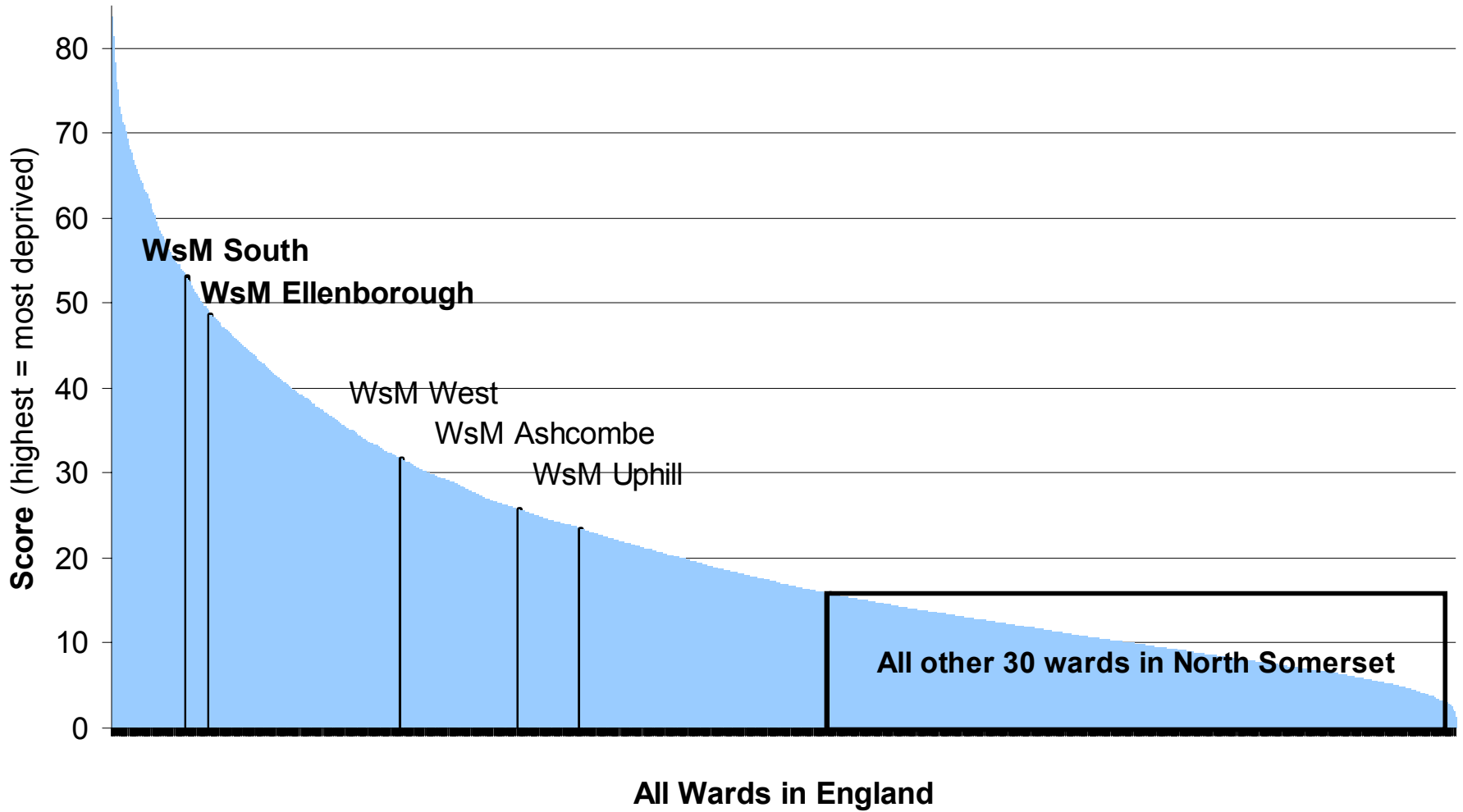

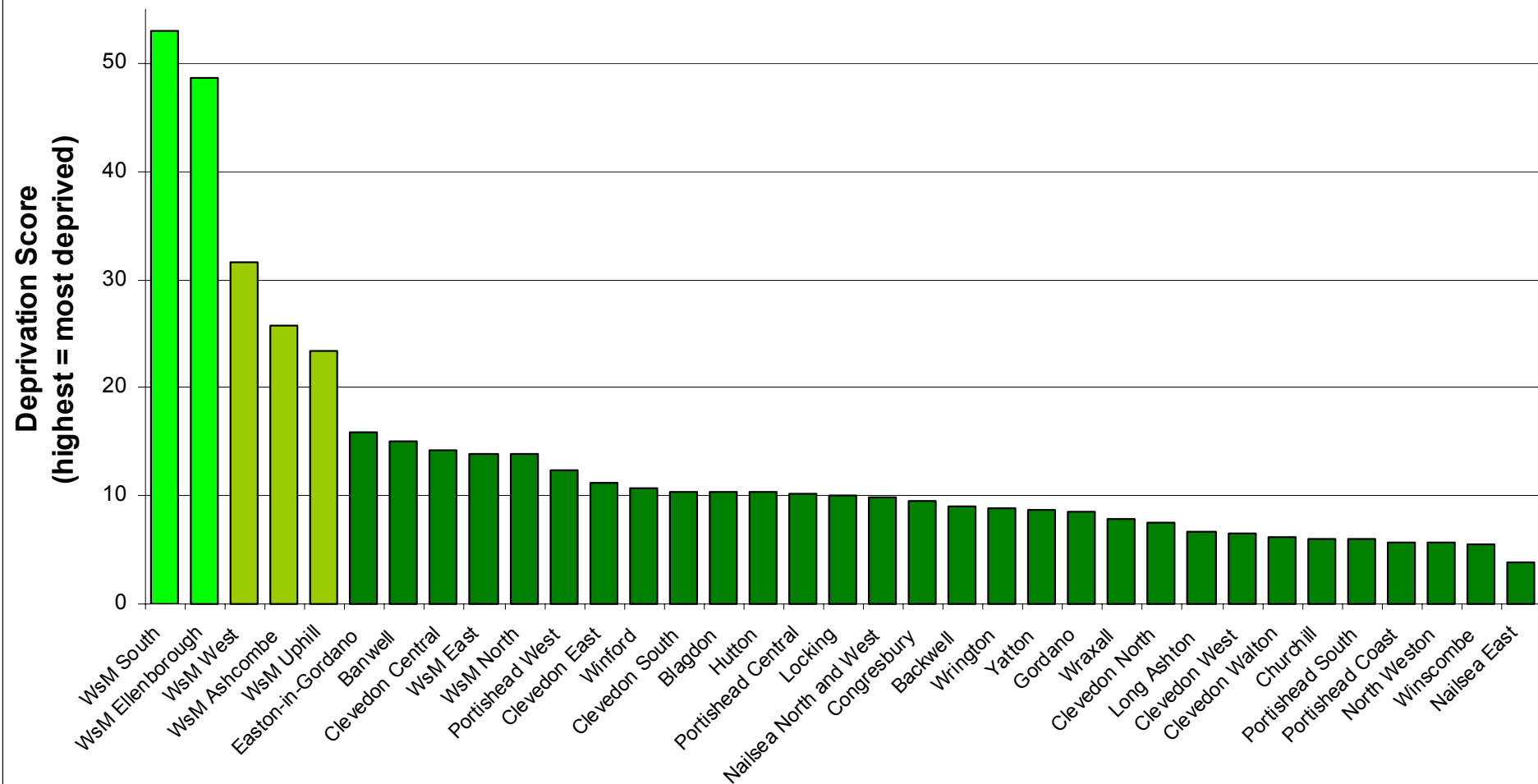

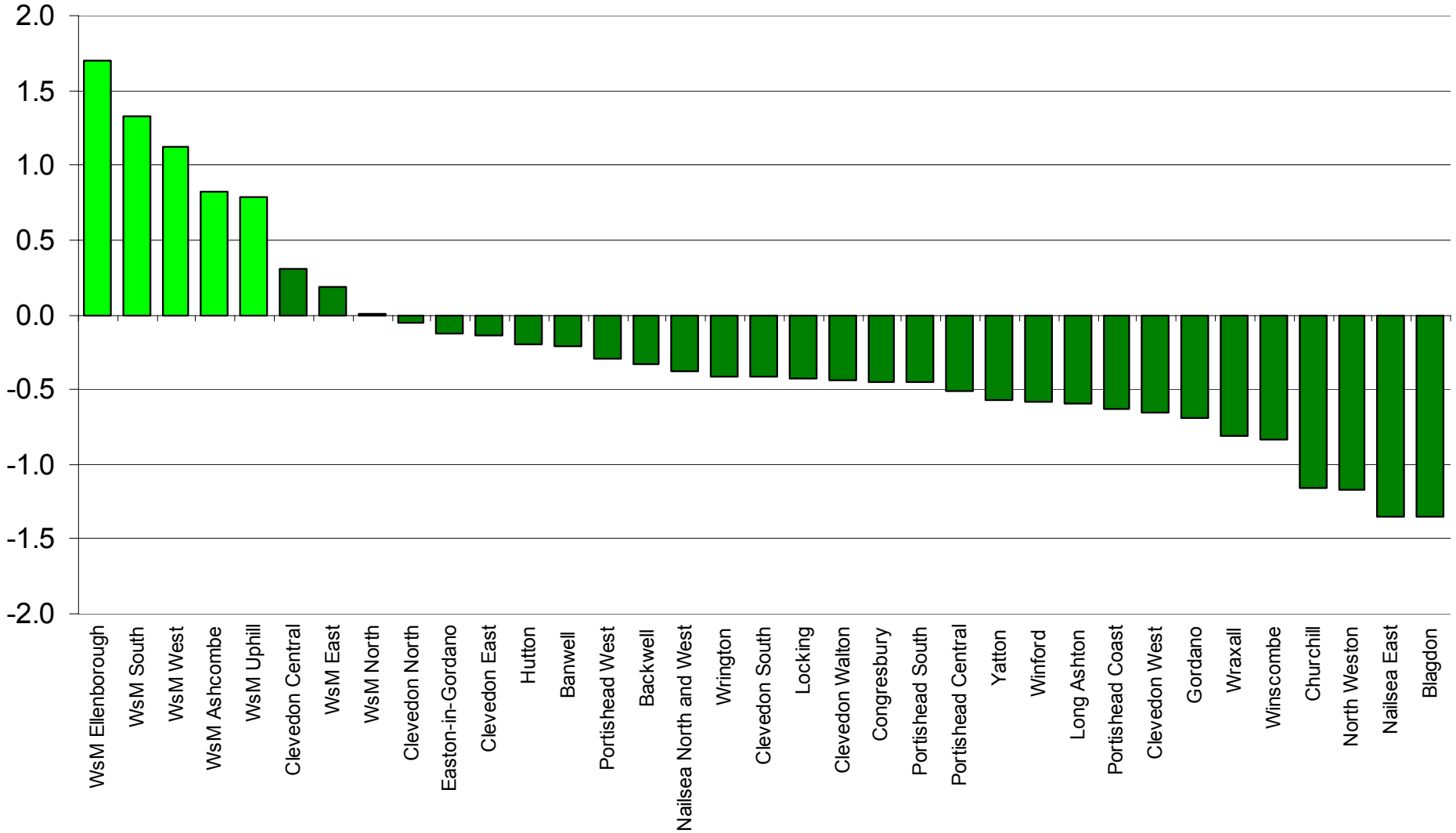
